Involves application to appropriate computer software. Note: Under no circumstances may this course be used to substitute for any general studies requirement; not may it be used to meet minimum degree requirements. Grade of C of better and successful completion of exit exam required.

ENG-1100 Preparatory English (3 Credits) [Add Course to Plan](#)

Developmental instruction in composition and mechanical skills needed to write clear, effective sentences and paragraphs. Involves application of appropriate computer software and a variety of written activities. Students are placed in this course, ENG 0096 or ENG 1101 depending on placement exam score; see the local campus testing center for specific cut-off scores. Students may also be required to attend weekly sessions at a writing and/or computer center. Note: Under No circumstances may this course substitute for any general studies requirement; not may it be used to meet minimum degree requirements. Grade of C of better required.
